3. That Greater Sudbury brand itself as The City of Lakes in its promotional materials.
4. That the GSLIAP present to the Budget Process and advise on seed funding required to enable all Lake Stewardship Groups to fulfill their mandate to protect and enhance Lake Water Quality.
